BEGINNING DANCE is a class for the four or five year old pre-Kindergarten dancer. This class explores the body's dance capabilities, and the world of rhythm and music. Each class has a theme relating to movement and music qualities, and features lots of stories and opportunities for creative movement. Class size is limited to 12, to give each child ample attention and care. Children must be 4 by October 1, 2009. Classes are 45 minutes long. See Dressing for Dance for uniform description.
