ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Princeton Ballet School aims to provide the atmosphere and training that will nurture both the potential artist and the dance student who studies only for the inherent rewards — self-discipline, physical fitness and a greater appreciation of movement and music.

In contrast to ballet schools which require the child's body to conform to the rigid expectations of the technique, we strive to allow the developing dancer to find out how her or his body can approach the technique; and, as the body matures, to grow technically in a safe, progressive way—to feel the dancing from within. Our children's classes go slowly and allow plenty of time for imagination and exploration, even as the children are mastering the basic concepts. For the older student, we continue to emphasize the importance of understanding the hows and whys of technique, so that safe work habits, personal responsibility and concentration become second nature. Our goal is to give the student dancers the tools of mind and body that they need to become a professional or to become a lifelong friend of the arts, while providing a supportive atmosphere for their endeavors.

COURSE SCHEDULES

The dancer must have turned the appropriate age by July 13, 2020. Schedule is subject to change.

NOTE: Children's classes in our Cranbury New Brunswick studio will resume in the fall.

HAND-IN-HAND: for three-year-old dancers and their parents. The class will focus on discovering the world of rhythm and dance through gentle exercises and dances hand in hand. Class size is limited to 12. Children must have turned 3 years old by July 13, 2020, and must be accompanied by a participating parent or caregiver. Participation is limited to the registered student and one adult. Experience the joy of dance with your child!

BEGINNING DANCE: for the 4-year-old student. A pre-ballet class which focuses on exploring the world of dance through movement and rhythm, games and stories.

CHILDREN'S BALLET 1: for the 5- to 7-year-old beginner.

CHILDREN'S BALLET 2: for the 8- to 12-year-old beginner

CHILDREN'S BALLET 3: for the 7- to 10-year-old student with one or more years of ballet training. (Princeton Ballet School students must have completed Primary B, Primary C, Middle School Ballet, or Level 1)

CHILDREN'S BALLET 4: for the 10 - 12 year old student with two or more years of ballet training. (Princeton Ballet School Students must have completed Middle School Ballet, Level 2, Level 3, or Level 4)
