Princeton Ballet School (PBS), the official school of American Repertory Ballet, is committed to inclusivity, accessibility, and excellence in dance education. Founded as the Princeton Ballet Society by Audrée Estey in 1954, PBS has become one of the largest nonprofit dance schools in the country with locations in Princeton, Cranbury, and New Brunswick, New Jersey.

IN-PERSON AND ONLINE INSTRUCTION

PBS offers both in-person and online classes for dancers of all levels, starting at age 3. Class sizes are limited in size, and students may opt to take the virtual option at any time. Classes will be separated into cohorts only if necessary, following guidance from the local health department and the Centers for Disease Control.

STUDIO POLICIES

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Students should arrive wearing their dance attire and will be greeted by a Princeton Ballet School representative at the studio entrance. All students must wear cover ups and street shoes when arriving and departing the building. Dressing rooms will remain closed during the School's stages of reopening after COVID-19. Bathrooms will be open but dancers will not be allowed to use the stalls as changing areas. In accordance with the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), state and local health officials, PBS has developed Safety Guidelines to protect the health of our students and employees. Princeton Studio Location: Parents are encouraged to park in the parking lot. Please do not wait in your car in the circle. The circular driveway is only used to drop off and pick up when it does not block the flow of the Shopping Center traffic. Students will enter the building based on their assigned class location:

Visitors (including parents, guardians, family, friends, and siblings) are not allowed in the building.

Cranbury Studio Location: There is ample parking in the back of the studio. The door on Main Street will not be open.

Visitors (including parents, guardians, family, friends, and siblings) are not allowed in the building.

New Brunswick Location: Metered parking is available, or parents may park in a nearby lot and walk students to the main entrance. Visitors, family and/or friends, will not be allowed in the School lobby or studio areas; only authorized employees and students may enter to minimize the number of people in the facility

Visitors (including parents, guardians, family, friends, and siblings) will not be allowed in the building so that we can keep pedestrian traffic as minimal as possible. Students taking Beginning Dance may have 1 parent/guardian or approved chaperone walk them to the studio entrance.

BEHAVIOR

Food and drinks are not allowed in the studios, but water is permitted. Food and drinks are allowed in the lobby areas only. Please dispose of trash in the receptacles. Water fountains will be closed temporarily during the School's stages of reopening after COVID-19, but water bottle filling stations will remain open.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Princeton Ballet School is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Please do not leave any valuables anywhere in our facilities.

ATTENDANCE POLICIES

Regular attendance is important for improving strength and skills required for progress.

If a student will not be in class or will be late, please notify the School Staff at princetonballetschool@arballet.org or 609.921.7758 prior to 2:00 PM. The student's full name, class level, date, and reason for lateness should be included.

Students in Level 1 and above who arrive more than 15 minutes late may be asked to observe the class and make it up at a later date. Warming up at the beginning of class is essential for injury prevention.

MISSED CLASSES

Students may take a makeup class in their level, or one level below, via Zoom ONLY. Extra classes may also be taken in advance virtually of classes the student will miss in the future. Students should try to take the makeup class as close to missed class as possible. Conservatory students may take a Flex class as a makeup via Zoom.

WEATHER AND EMERGENCY CLOSING PROCEDURES

In case an emergency closing is needed, an announcement for morning classes will be made by 8:00 AM. An announcement for afternoon and evening classes will be announced no later than 1:30 PM.

Missed classes can be made up via Zoom. No additional days will be added to the calendar.

All students will be assessed based on level of proficiency within the syllabus for their year, and readiness to progress to the next level. Families will be notified when reports are available in the Parent Portal. Students will **not** be receiving formal evaluations by mail.
